The product can be converted by all conventional roll conversion technologies including: Letterpress, Offset, Screenprinting, UV flexo and Water-based flexo. This product is also suitable for variable information printing in: Direct thermal printing systems at printing speeds up to 200 mm/sec (based on the printer's set up). IMPORTANT NOTES: Due to the thermographic properties, exposure above 50°C may cause premature imaging or discolouration. Inks containing alcohol or volatile organic solvents may cause discolouration of the thermosensitive coating. It is advisable to test inks and varnishes before conversion.


### Shelf Life
